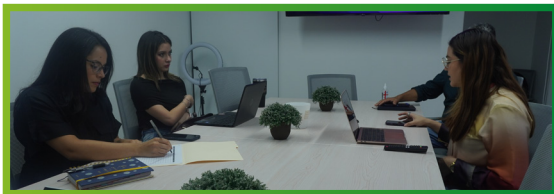

One of the **project's initial activities** was holding **workshops with experts** from the green sector in Costa Rica and Honduras. The goal was to conduct a **thorough assessment, establish partnerships with strategic allies, and understand the beneficiaries needs to develop tools** that address these needs through digitalization.



These workshops involved over 30 participants from the green sector in both countries, including producers, trainers, technicians, and representatives from government entities, among others.
