

The Next DigiBuild Chapter Is Underway

Following the results achieved during the pilot phase of the Digital Transformation for the Green Sector training programme, DigiBuild project partners are preparing to launch a new edition of the course, which will begin on September 9 and run through November 3, 2025.



The new edition will maintain the academic structure developed by the project's international consortium, consisting of five specialized modules covering topics such as digital agriculture, technologies supporting compliance with the European Green Deal, data-driven smart agriculture, agricultural innovation, and digital marketing for the agricultural sector.

The improvements introduced for this new edition focus primarily on enhancing the participant experience by streamlining access to the learning platform, strengthening follow-up and support mechanisms throughout the course, and optimizing procedures related to international certification.

The programme is aimed at students, producers, extension officers, educators, public-sector professionals, entrepreneurs, and other stakeholders connected to the agri-food sector, as well as anyone



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interested in strengthening their knowledge of digital transformation applied to agriculture.

Although the initiative is primarily targeted at participants from Costa Rica and Honduras, the pilot experience demonstrated that the virtual format makes it possible to expand the programme's reach and facilitate participation from interested individuals in other countries.

The results obtained during the first edition highlighted the growing demand for knowledge related to the digitalization of the agricultural sector and confirmed the importance of continuing to strengthen capacities to address the productive, environmental, and commercial challenges facing modern agriculture.

With this new edition, DigiBuild reaffirms its commitment to providing tools, knowledge, and learning opportunities that contribute to building a more innovative, competitive, and future-ready green sector.
